Philip Mountbatten, Duke of Edinburgh 1921 - 2021

Many of the members may wonder why this man is featured in an Australian Rotary publication. Quite a few of us are of English heritage and are aware of the massive contribution he has made to his adopted country for 80-odd years; firstly as an officer in the navy during WWII when he was mentioned in dispatches for manning a searchlight at the Battle of Matapan, directing a bean on enemy shipping giving the allied ships clear targets. He has subsequently acted as the unappointed Consort to the Queen since 1952.

He has been a lifetime advocate of physical fitness, responsible for the founding of the Duke of Edinburgh International Award Scheme the has allowed some 600,000 young people from 14 to 24 years to engage in community service.

He made over 20,000 solo public appearances, representing the Royal Family. He has been patron of 800 organisations including the National Playing Fields Association, BAFTA and the International Equestrian Federation. He was instrumental in the foundation of the Australian Conservation Foundation

His financial contribution has included supporting the Government in legislation to require the Queen to pay tax on income from the Royal Estates and the abandon the policy of maintaining a Royal Yacht. He has supported Commonwealth Countries in the move to a republic. He *will* be missed.
