You can apply to be part of a team of up to twelve, to participate in this great Rotary experience of friendship and hospitality from **26th April to 6th May 2022**. Hosting will be provided in 3 areas - North West Tasmania, Launceston and Hobart.

The exchange could provide a great opportunity to visit other parts of Tasmania either before or after the exchange.

Rotary travel insurance will cover the exchange plus up to 21 days private travel. Please note that pandemics including COVID 19 are not covered under this insurance policy.

Recently the Council on Resolutions voted on 36 proposed resolutions. The adopted resolutions are recommendations for consideration to the Rotary International Board who make a decision on those to be accepted.

Attached are the results of the voting, but just a couple of items which may be of interest to you all:

Adopted:

21R -16 Consider setting an upper age limit of 35 for membership in a Rotaract club

21R 17 Consider changing Rotary Youth Leadership Awards to Rotary Youth Leadership Academy

21R-19 Consider amending the fourth area of focus to include senior health

Rejected:

21R-05 Replace the annual presidential theme with a permanent theme of "Service Above Self"

21R-14 Consider ensuring that at least 30 percent of future Rotary Foundation Trustees are women, and set a goal to have a female chair of The Rotary Foundation

21R-29 Consider endorsing the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons

21R-33 Change the allocation of the District Designated Fund and the World Fund (60/40 proposed currently 50/50)
